# Spring Term

### **English**



In the Spring Term we will write;

# Maths



In the Spring Term we will continue our work on multiplication and division. We will then move onto to fractions and decimals, where children will learn to add and subtract fractions and decimals and find a fraction of an amount.

#### Science

Spring 1 – Why we eat? We will explore our digestive system and how our bodies process food and drink.

Spring 2 – The Rainforest. We will explore rainforests including microhabitats and the impact of environmental change on the Rainforest and its ecosystem.

#### Wider Curriculum

**History** – Our topic is the Roman Empire. We will look at key events and why the Romans invaded Britain.

**Geography -** Our topic is the Rainforests. We will explore where Rainforests are located around the worlds, and take an in depth look at the impact of deforestation.

**PSHE – W**e will explore managing risk (including online safety) and rights and respect (including how to make a difference).

RE - Our Key Questions are;

Could Buddha's teaching make the world a better place? Is forgiveness always possible?

**Music** - We will explore different musical structures with songs linked to our Geography and Science topics.

**Art** – We will explore how the rainforest has been represented in art, exploring the work of Henri Rouseau.

**DT** – This half term we will make our own soup.
