# Spring Term

#### English

In the Spring Term we will write;

## Maths



In the Spring Term we will continue our work on multiplication and division, where the children will be learning to multiply and divide with 4 digit numbers. We will then continue our work on fractions where children will learn to multiply fractions and find a fraction of an amount.

#### Science

Spring 1 – Materials. We will investigate whether a range of materials are magnetic, absorbent and can conduct electricity. We will evaluate our results to determine which materials are most suitable for Viking clothing.

Spring 2 – Life Cycles. We will explore the human life cycle and compare this to the life cycles of other animals and plants.

# Wider Curriculum

**History** – Our topic is Anglo Saxons and Vikings. We will explore why Vikings invaded Anglo Saxon Kingdoms and describe everyday life in a Viking settlement. We can't wait for our Viking Workshop!

**Geography -** Our topic is Scandinavia. We will describe the locations settled and visited by the Vikings and investigate the climate and biomes of Sweden.

**PSHE** – we will explore managing risk (including online safety) and our rights and responsibilities linked to keeping ourselves healthy.

**RE** - Our Key Questions are; Are Sikh stories important today? And how significant is it for Christians to believe God intended Jesus to die?

 $\boldsymbol{Music}$  - We will explore different musical structures with songs linked to life cycles and keeping healthy.

**Art** – We will explore how different artists have represented the sky in their work including the work of Van Gogh.

**DT –** This half term we will design and make our own Viking longboats.
