This term our topics are 'Once upon a time' where we will be reading and learning about lots of traditional tales. Our second topic is 'Animal Antics' where we will be learning about different types of animals, where they live and also the life cycle of some animals. This topic links to our trip to the Tropical Butterfly House.

In maths we are looking at consolidating our knowledge of the numbers 1 to 20. We will also be extending our knowledge of numbers by adding and taking away, sharing and grouping. We will also be furthering our knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes.



In our topic sessions we will be investigating how to help the gingerbread man cross the river without getting wet, which objects move the furthest when the big bad wolf blows them. We will also be baking bread with the little red hen. We will be looking at animals and their habitats, finding out how spiders make their webs and much more.
