Through fun, practical and visual activities, children will be supported to build longer sentences, develop their vocabulary and communicate their ideas with greater confidence.

We will explore how numbers can be made and broken apart, while building confidence with counting and number recognition. Our main focus will be working 1:1 with each child to support their individual Maths targets, providing personalised support and opportunities to practise and apply their skills.
